The "Venetian Twist" series by Luxe Faucets, featuring hand-blown glass handles, exemplifies this trend beautifully.

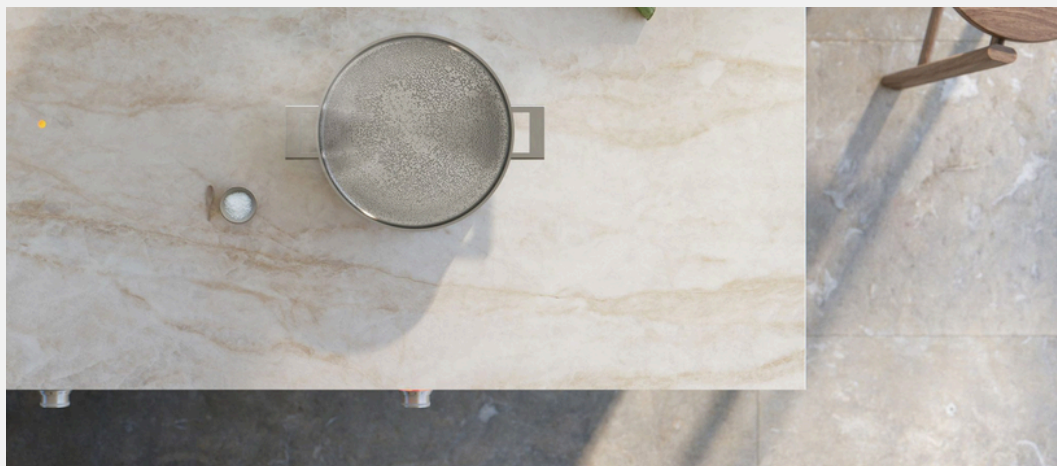
Soft-Tech and AI.

Philip Jeffries Summer 2024 collection reminds us that large format florals and botanicals don't have to be feminine with gilded designs featuring organic curves and textures.



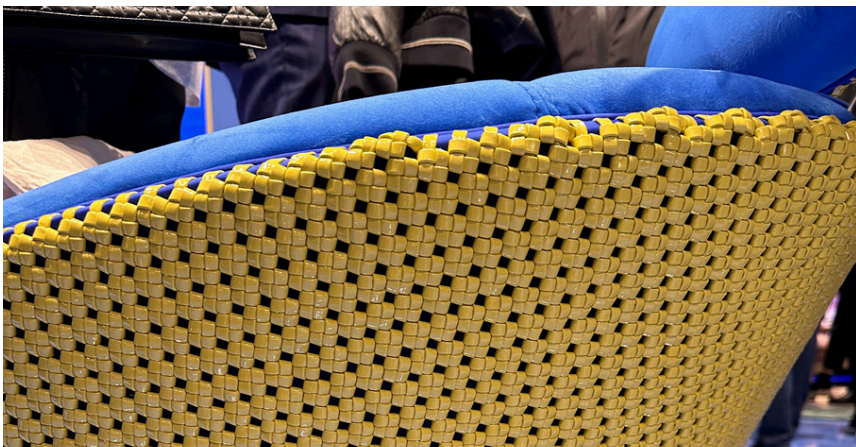


Woven Elements for Plumbing & Upholstery.

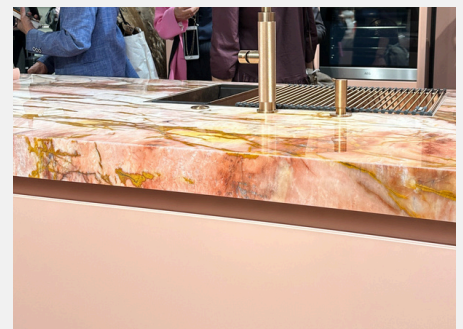


The Warmth of *Brown, Apricot, and Prickly Pink* Palettes.

Colorful Concrete Basins from Kast, a Kohler Brand, perfectly captures this trend, offering a palette that serves those looking for these trending hues in the bath space.

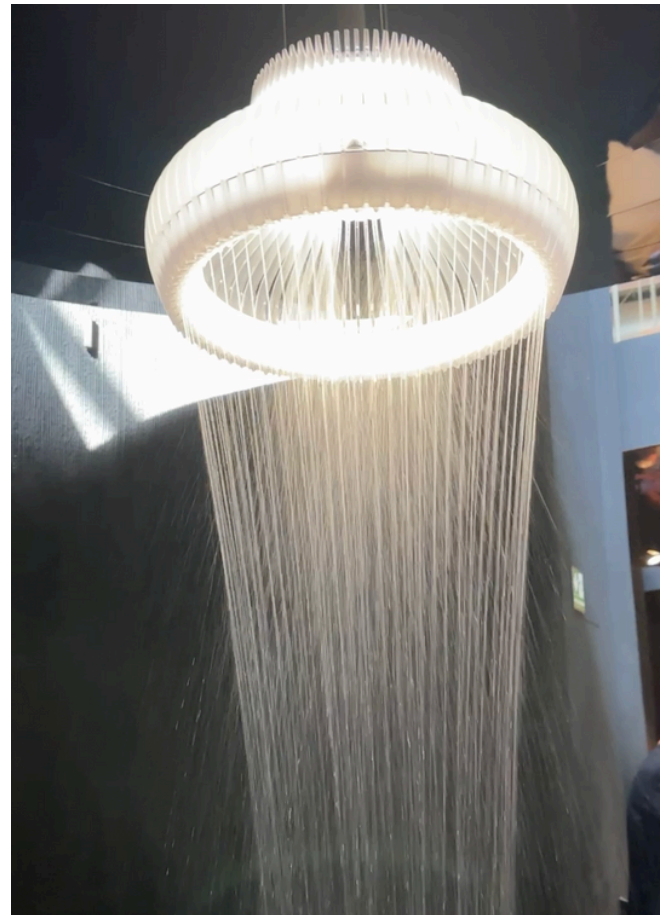




All About Rituals: Wellness & Sustainability.
